



CAR ROCKER COMBO

Instructions

Maintenance:

- Before each use, make sure all the fasteners are firmly tightened and all the parts are securely fastened.
- Always wipe the product with a plane, dry cloth regularly and avoid using harsh chemicals.

Caution:

- The product must be assembled by an adult only. Keep all the parts out of the reach of kids until the product is fully assembled.
- For safety, kids should always face forward while riding the car rocker.
- Packaging materials are not safe to play with and should be kept away from kids.
- Always use the product on an even surface. Using it on a rough surface can make it unsteady and may cause injuries.
- Adult supervision is recommended when kids are using this product.

Warnings:

- Always assemble on a non-abrasive surface to avoid scratches and make sure there are no sharp objects placed nearby.
- Avoid over-tightening the nuts as it may cause damage to the parts.

Warning: Before using as a car ride on, make sure no nut is fixed between the rear wheels.

Before starting the assembly, lay out a carpet on the floor to avoid scratches.



- Take the front wheel assembly and remove the pre-fitted nut.
- Remove the pre-fitted nut between the rear wheels of the car body assembly.
- Insert the axle of the front wheel assembly through the base hole of the car body and push it until it protrudes from the top hole as shown in the image.



Take the steering and put it on the top of front wheel axle (horn should be oriented towards the front) and fasten both together with the front assembly nut that you removed earlier.

Note: 1. Avoid overtightening the nut as it may cause damage to the components. Tighten just enough to ensure a secure fit without applying excessive force. If you notice any restriction in movement of the steering after tightening, loosen the nut slightly.

2. Before using as a car ride on, make sure no nut is fixed between the rear wheels.

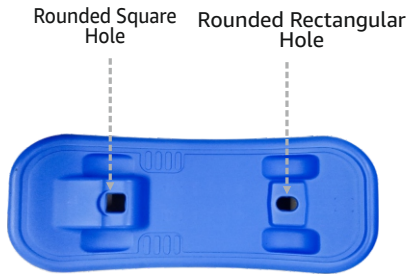
Required Assembly Parts



Subassembly (Step 1)



Rocker Base x 1



Rounded Square Hole

Rounded Rectangular Hole



Locking Tab



Align the locking tab between the front wheels of the car ride on (subassembly- step 1) with the rounded square hole on the rocker base and firmly push the subassembly downwards until the locking tab is engaged with the rocker base.



Threaded Pin



Press down on the rear portion of the car ride on subassembly making sure the threaded pin (between the rear wheels) passes through the rounded rectangular hole on the rocker base. Put the car body nut (removed in step 1) onto the protruding end of the threaded pin and tighten.

Your versatile Car Rocker Combo, designed to function both as a Ride On and a Rocker, is now ready for use!



Warning: Before using as a car ride on, make sure no nut is fixed between the rear wheels.
