



CASTLE SLIDE WITH BASKETBALL

Instructions

Maintenance:

- Before each use, ascertain that all the fasteners are firmly tightened and all the parts are securely fastened.
- Always wipe the product with a plane, dry cloth regularly and avoid using harsh chemicals.
- Do not discard the spare fasteners as they can come in handy in future.

Caution:

- The product must be assembled by an adult only. Keep all the parts out of the reach of kids until the product is fully assembled.
- Always sit upright and go down feet first on the slide. Climbing up the side, sliding down headfirst or in the standing position can be fatal and should be avoided at all costs.
- Abstain from jumping off the slide seat.
- Packaging materials are not safe to play with and should be kept away from kids.
- Always place the product on an even surface. Using it on concrete or a rough surface can make it unsteady and may cause injuries.
- This product is intended for use by kids over 2 years of age.
- Adult supervision is recommended when kids are using this product.

Warnings:

- Always assemble on a non-abrasive surface, ideally a carpet, to avoid scratches and make sure there are no sharp objects placed nearby.
- Do not connect any external item (chain, rope or cables) to the product.
- Avoid over-tightening the fasteners as it may cause damage to the parts.

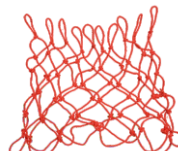

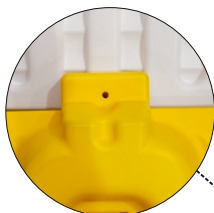


Allen Bolt & Washer x 1

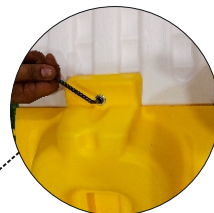
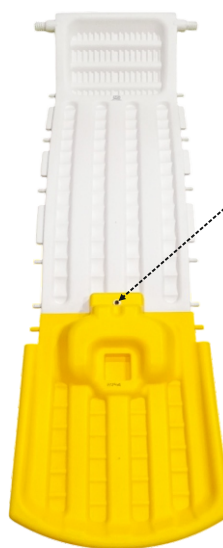
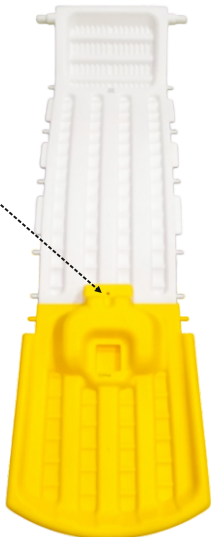
Before starting the assembly, lay out a carpet on the floor to avoid scratches.



Screw Holes Aligned



Screw Holes



Take the big and small slides, turn them face down and align their screw holes.

Make sure the screw holes of the small slide are over the screw holes of the big slide.

Put a washer on an allen bolt and insert the allen bolt (with washer) into the aligned screw holes. Tighten the allen bolt with the allen key, securing both slides together.

Subassembly (Step 1)



Handrail (Left & Right) x 2



Small Nut x 12



Key x 1



Take the left handrail and align its holes with the threaded pins on the left side of the subassembly assembled in step 1. Push the left handrail so that its hole engage with the threaded pins of the subassembly. Put a small nut onto the end of the each threaded pin and tighten all the nuts one by one with the key provided in the packaging. Similarly, secure the right handrail to the slide subassembly.

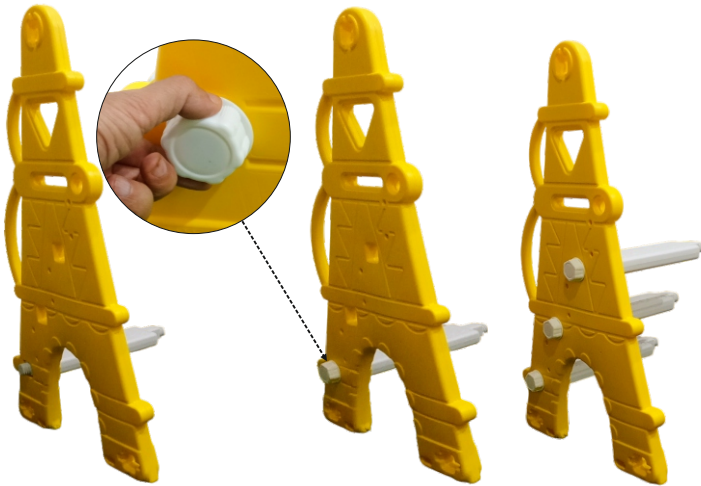
Left Panel x 1

Take all the three steps from the packaging and fasten them one by one to the left panel with big nuts, using one big nut per step.



Secure the slide subassembly (step 2) to the left panel with one big nut.

Subassembly (Step 3)



Right Panel x 1



Happy Step x 3

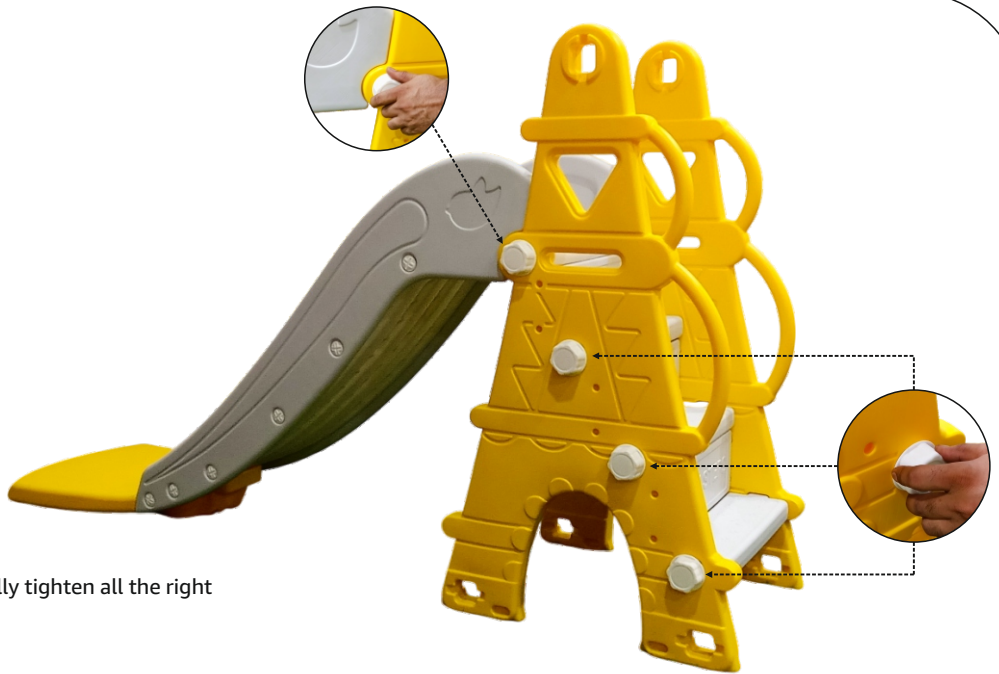


Take the right panel and attach it to the subassembly assembled in step 3 with four big nuts.

Note: Do not fully tighten the right panel nuts at this stage.



Take a happy step and position it vertically at an angle between the two steps. Gently push the one side of the happy step, locking the pins on its side into small circular slots on the right panel. Thereafter, apply pressure on the other side of the happy step to lock the pin on the other side into place.



Similarly, secure the two other happy steps and fully tighten all the right panel nuts.

Subassembly (Step 4)



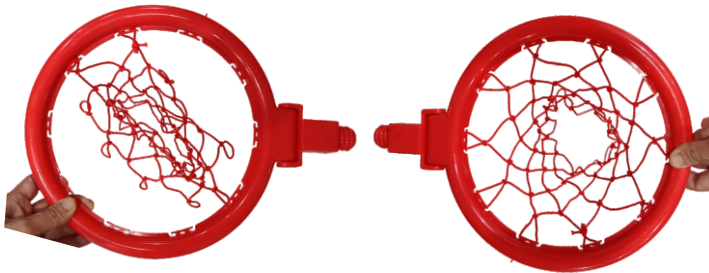
Basketball Ring x 1



Basketball Net x 1



Big Nut x 1



Take the basketball net from the packaging, hold one of its loops with your fingers and wrap the loop around a pair of hooks. Move to the next pair of hook and repeat the process, securing each loop of the net to the basketball ring.

Secure the basketball ring to the subassembly (step 4) with one big nut at the position as shown in the image.

Your Castle Slide is now ready for use! Let the good times roll!
