

DINO SLIDE

Instructions

Maintenance:

- · Before each use, ascertain that all the fasteners are firmly tightened and all the parts are securely fastened.
- Always wipe the product with a plane, dry cloth regularly and avoid using harsh chemicals.
- Do not discard the spare fasteners as they can come in handy in future.

Caution:

- · The product must be assembled by an adult only. Keep all the parts out of the reach of kids until the product is fully assembled.
- Always sit upright and go down feet first on the slide. Climbing up the side, sliding down headfirst or in the standing position can be fatal and should be avoided at all costs.
- Abstain from jumping off the slide seat and hanging on the basketball ring.
- · Always place the product on an even surface. Using it on concrete or a rough surface can make it unsteady and may cause injuries.
- Packaging materials are not safe to play with and should be kept away from kids.
- This product is intended for use by kids over 2 years of age.
- Adult supervision is recommended when kids are using the product. .

Warnings:

- · Always assemble on a non-abrasive surface, ideally a carpet, to avoid scratches and make sure there are no sharp objects placed nearby.
- Do not connect any external item (chain, rope or cables) to the product.
- Avoid over-tightening the fasteners as it may cause damage to the parts.

Assembly Instructions




Required Assembly Parts





Before starting the assembly, lay out a carpet on the floor to avoid scratches.




Allen Bolt x 2



Small Nut x 10






Take the big slide and the small slide, and turn them face down. Align their screw holes making sure the small slide screw holes are over the screw holes of the big slide.

Take two allen bolts from the packaging and put a washer onto both the allen bolts.

Insert one allen bolt (with washer) into each aligned screw hole and tighten both the allen bolts with an allen key, securing both slides together.






A. Take the right handrail, align its holes with the small threaded pins on the edge of the slide subassembly.

Repeat steps (A) to (C) to fasten the left handrail to the slide subassembly.

Note: Ensure the handrail is positioned correctly, following the orientation shown in the image above.

- B. Gently push the handrail sideways towards the slide subassembly, ensuring each of the five $threaded\ pins\ of\ the\ slide\ subassembly\ enter\ the\ corresponding\ holes\ on\ the\ handrail.$
- C. Place a small nut onto the end of each threaded pin and then tighten all the small nuts one by one with the key (provided in the packaging), securing both the slide subassembly and the right handrail together.





- A. Take a step from the packaging and align the threaded pin on one of its shorter edges with the designated hole on the side panel.
- B. Push the step sideways towards the side panel, ensuring the threaded pin passes through the designated hole and extends out the other side.
- C. Put a big nut onto the protruding end of the threaded pin and tighten, fastening both the step and the side panel together.




Similarly, attach the two other steps to the side panel with big nuts.

- A. Take the slide subassembly (step 1) and align the big threaded pin on its top edge with the designated hole on the side panel.
- B. Push the side panel sideways towards the slide subassembly, making sure the big threaded pin passes through the hole and extends out the other side.
- C. Put a big nut onto the protruding end of the threaded pin and tighten, securing both the slide subassembly and the side panel together.





Fasten the other side panel to the subassembly (assembled in step 2) with four big nuts.



Take the basketball ring and mount it on the side panel by tightening a medium nut with the key provided in the packaging.







Paste the stickers on both the side panels at the positions as shown in the image.
