Instructions

Maintenance:

- Before each use, ascertain that all the fasteners are firmly tightened and all the parts are securely fastened.
- Always wipe the product with a plane, dry cloth regularly and avoid using harsh chemicals.
- Do not discard the spare key and fasteners as they can come in handy in future.

Caution:

- The product must be assembled by an adult only. Keep all the parts out of the reach of kids until the product is fully assembled.
- Always sit upright and go down feet first on the slide. Climbing up the side, sliding down headfirst or in the standing position can be fatal and should be avoided at all costs.
- Abstain from jumping off the slide seat and hanging on the basketball ring.
- Kids should always hold on to the handrails while going down the slide.
- Always place the product on an even surface. Using it on concrete or a rough surface can make it unsteady and may cause injuries.
- Packaging materials are not safe to play with and should be kept away from kids.
- This product is intended for use by kids over 2 years of age.
- Adult supervision is recommended when kids are using this product.

Warnings:

- Always assemble on a non-abrasive surface, ideally a carpet, to avoid scratches and make sure there are no sharp objects placed nearby.
- Avoid over-tightening the fasteners as it may cause damage to the parts.

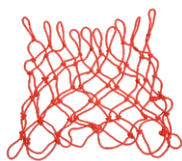

House Gate x 2



Key x 1



Medium Nut x 10



Aisle Platform x 1



Lower Baffle x 1

Before starting the assembly, lay out a carpet on the floor to avoid scratches.



Take the aisle platform and a house gate from the packaging. Align the tabs and the threaded pins on one of the longer edges of the aisle platform with the designated slots at the top of the house gate. Push the aisle platform sideways, guiding its threaded pins and tabs into the designated slots, and secure both (aisle platform and house gate) together by tightening three medium nuts with the key.

Note: While placing the aisle platform, confirm that its smooth side is facing up.



Similarly, secure the other house gate on the other side of the aisle platform by tightening three medium nuts with the key provided in the packaging.

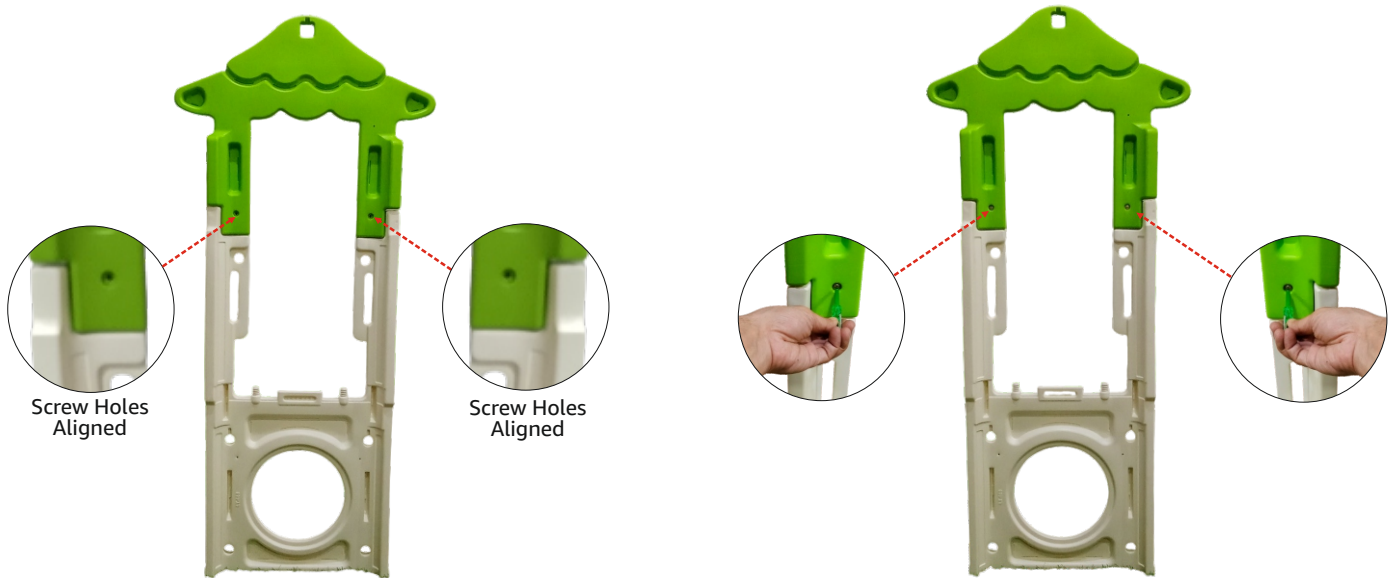
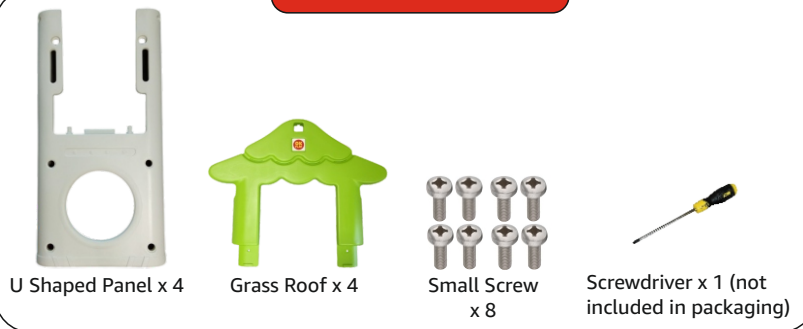


Take a lower baffle from the packaging, align its holes with the threaded pins on the side of the house gates and secure them together with four medium nuts.

Note: Make sure the lower baffle is positioned correctly, following the orientation as shown in the images.

STEP



Take a U-shaped panel and a grass roof, and align their screw holes making sure the screw holes of the grass roof are over the screw holes of the U-shaped panel.

Insert a small screw into each of the aligned screw holes and tighten both the screws one by one with a screwdriver.

Repeat the above steps to assemble three more Tree roof-U shaped panel subassemblies.

At the end of step 1, you should have four Tree roof-U shaped panel subassemblies.

STEP





Take a tree roof-U shaped subassembly (step 2) and secure it to the lower baffle of the subassembly (step 1) with two medium nuts as shown in the images above.



Take a lower baffle from the packaging and secure it to the U-shaped panel of the subassembly with two medium nuts.



Take a rainbow escalator and attach its one end to the grass roof of the subassembly with a big nut as shown in the images above.

4 STEP

Required Assembly Parts



Take a U shaped-grass roof subassembly (step 2) and secure it to the subassembly (step 3) with a big nut and four medium nuts as shown in the images above.



Take a small platform from the packaging and place it (smooth side facing up) inside the subassembly at the position as shown in the image above.

Note: Make sure the platform is positioned correctly, with the edge having rectangular grooves is away from the big platform.

5 STEP





Take a lower baffle and secure it to the subassembly (step 4) with four medium nuts as shown in the images above.
Note: Confirm that the lower baffle is positioned correctly, following the orientation as shown in the images.



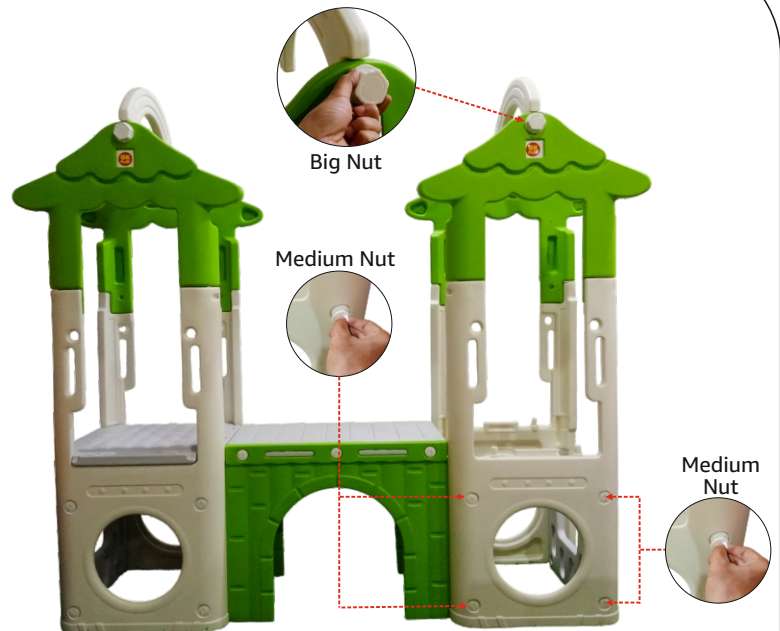
Take a U shape-grass roof subassembly (step 2) and secure it to the lower baffle with two medium nuts.



Take another lower baffle and secure it to the U shape-grass roof subassembly (step 2) with two medium nuts.



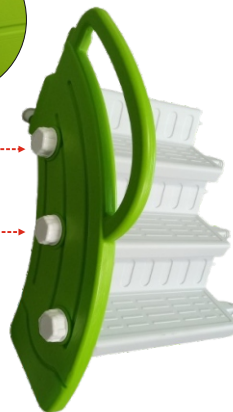
Secure the rainbow escalator to the U-shaped-grass roof with one big nut.



Take a U shape-grass roof subassembly (step 2) and secure it in place with one big nut and four medium nuts as shown in the figure above.

6 STEP

Required Assembly Parts



Take a step and a step side panel (smooth side facing outwards) from the packaging. Align the threaded pin on the side of the step with the designated hole on the step side panel and push the step sideways, sliding its threaded pin through the hole. Use a big nut to secure both the step and the step side panel together.

Note: Each stair step panel has a pre-fitted medium nut; do not remove it at this stage.

Take the two other steps and fasten them one by one to the step side panel with big nuts.

Follow the above mentioned steps to secure the other step side panel .



7 STEP

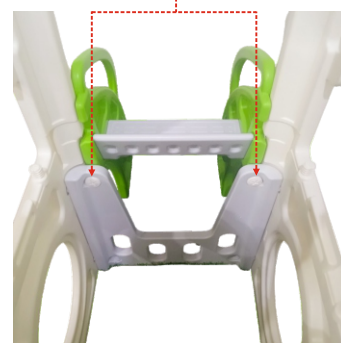

Platform x 1



Pre-fitted Nut



Remove the pre-fitted nuts from the stair step panels and secure the stair panel to the subassembly with the pre-fitted nuts at the position as shown in the images above.

Small platform edge with rectangular grooves is next to the stair subassembly



Place the platform between the two tree roof-U shape subassemblies as shown in the image above. .

Note: While placing the platform, make sure its smooth side is facing up and the edge with rectangular grooves is next to the stair subassembly.

8 STEP

Subassembly (Step 7)



Large Fencing x 2



Small Fencing x 1



Screw x 2



Small Screw x 4



Screwdriver x 1 (not included in packaging)



Take a large fencing and attach it in place on the subassembly (step 7) by tightening two small screws with a screwdriver.

Note: Make sure the large fencing is positioned correctly with the rectangular tabs on its underside at the bottom.

Secure the other large fencing in the same way, placing it directly above the front house gate.



Small Fencing



Take the small fencing from the packaging and secure it into position by tightening two screws with the screwdriver.

Note: Make sure the small fencing is positioned correctly with the rectangular tabs on its underside at the bottom and these rectangular tabs fit into the rectangular slots on the platform.

Subassembly (Step 8)



Medium Nut x 8

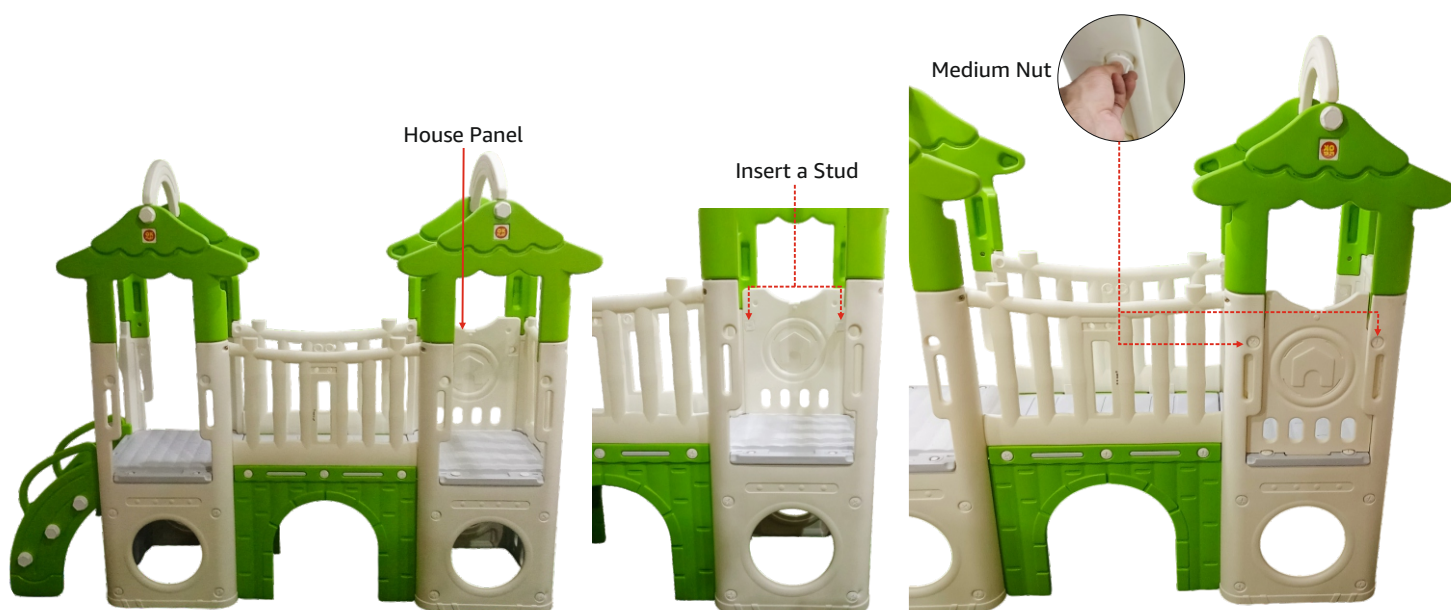

House Panel x 2



Tighten two medium nuts on the holes along the rear edge (when viewed from the front) of each small platform.



Take a house panel , position it above the small platform (adjacent to the small fencing) and secure the house panel in place with two studs and two medium nuts.

Note: Make sure the house panel is positioned correctly, following the orientation as shown in the images.



Similarly, fix the other house panel in place on the small platform next to the stair step panel with two studs and two medium nuts.

10 STEP

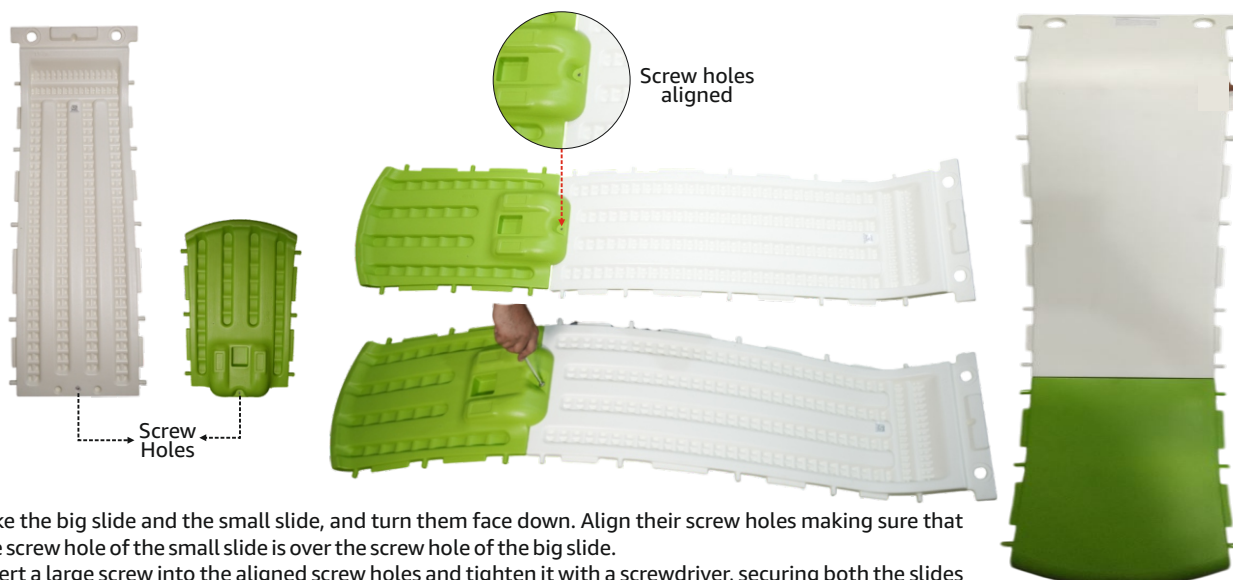

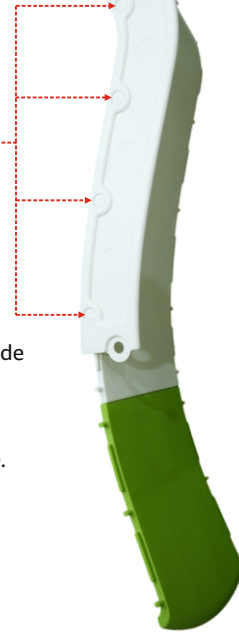
Take the climbing ladder and secure it to the subassembly by tightening two medium nuts with the key provided in the packaging.

11 STEP

Required Assembly Parts

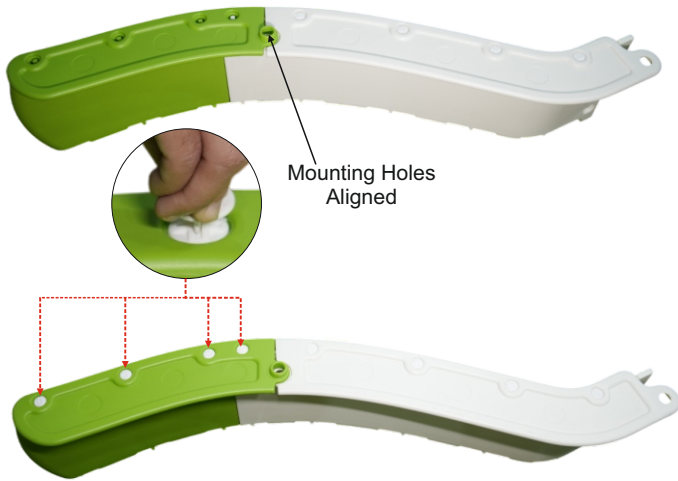


Take the big slide and the small slide, and turn them face down. Align their screw holes making sure that the screw hole of the small slide is over the screw hole of the big slide. Insert a large screw into the aligned screw holes and tighten it with a screwdriver, securing both the slides together.

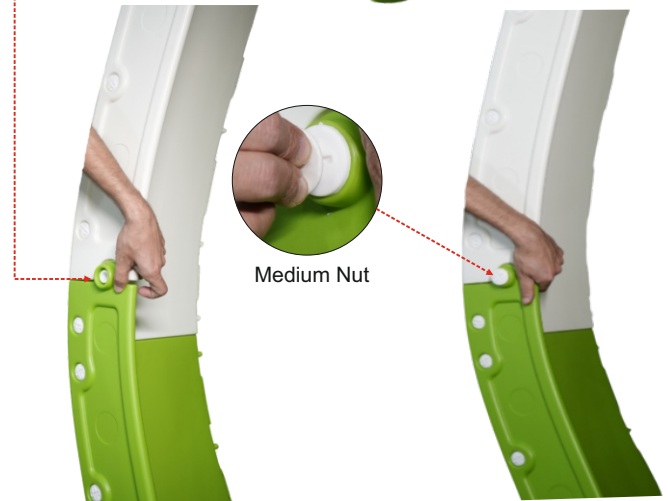


Take a left big slide handrail and align its holes with the threaded pins on the left side of the slide subassembly. Carefully push the left handrail so that its holes are engaged with the threaded pins. Place a nut on the end of the threaded pin and tighten. Do the same with the three other threaded pins.

Note: Make sure the left handrail is positioned correctly, following the orientation as shown in the image.



Stud inserted



Take a left small slide handrail, align its holes with the threaded pins on the left side of the small slide and secure them together with four small nuts.

Note: Make sure the left small handrail is positioned correctly, following the orientation as shown in the image. Also, the mounting hole of the left small handrail is exactly over the mounting hole of the left big handrail.

- A. Insert a stud into the aligned mounting holes from underneath.
- B. Put a medium nut on the threaded end of the stud and tighten, securing both the handrails together.

Repeat the above series of steps to secure the right big and small handrails in place.

Secure the slide subassembly (assembled in step 11) to the subassembly (step 10) with two medium nuts.

Basketball Ring x 1



Basketball Net x 1



Key x 1



Small Nut x 2



Take the basketball net from the packaging, hold one of its loops with your fingers and wrap the loop around a pair of hooks. Move to the next pair of hooks and repeat the process, securing each loop of the net to the basketball ring.



Fasten the basketball ring (with net) to the large fencing (fixed above the front house gate) by tightening two small nuts with the key.



14 STEP

Telescope x 2



Take both the telescopes from the packaging and mount a telescope on each house panel as shown in the image.
