



PONY ROCKER COMBO

Instructions

Maintenance:

- Before each use, ascertain that all the fasteners are firmly tightened and all the parts are securely fastened.
- Always wipe the product with a plain, dry cloth regularly and avoid using harsh chemicals.

Caution:

- The product must be assembled by an adult only. Keep all the parts out of the reach of kids until the product is fully assembled.
- For safety, kids should always face forward while riding the rocker.
- Always place the product on an even surface. Using it on concrete or a rough surface can make it unsteady and may cause injuries.
- Always hold onto the handles while using the rocker.
- Packaging materials are not safe to play with and should be kept away from kids.
- Adult supervision is recommended when kids are using this product.

Warnings:

- Always assemble on a non-abrasive surface, ideally a carpet, to avoid scratches and make sure there are no sharp objects placed nearby.
- Do not connect any external item (chain, rope or cables) to the product.
- Avoid over-tightening the nut as it may cause damage to the parts.



Warning: Before using as a Ride On, ensure no nut is fixed between the rear wheels.




Ride on Body Assembly x 1



Handle Set x 1

Before starting the assembly, lay out a carpet on the floor to avoid scratches.



Firmly hold one handle and rotate the other one (as indicated in the image above) until the two handles are completely separated from each other.



Insert the threaded end of both the handles into their designated slots on the ride on body assembly. Hold onto the handle with internal threads to keep it stationary and rotate the handle with external threads until its stop ring makes firm and full contact with the ride on body assembly, securing both handles in place.



2 STEP

Required Assembly Parts



Paste the eye labels on the ride on subassembly (assembled in step 1) at the positions as shown in the image above.



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3 STEP

Required Assembly Parts



Take the ride on subassembly (assembled in step 2), align the hook between the front wheels of the subassembly with the square cut on the rocker base and firmly push the subassembly downward until the hook is fully inserted into the square cut.

Align the thread between the rear wheels of the subassembly with the hole on the rocker base and secure them together with the nut as shown in the image.

Your dual-purpose Pony Rocker, serving as both a ride on and a rocker, is now ready for use.



Warning: Before using as a Ride On, ensure no nut is fixed between the rear wheels.
