



SUPREME SLIDE

Instructions

Maintenance:

- Before each use, ascertain that all the fasteners are firmly tightened and all the parts are securely fastened.
- Always wipe the product with a plane, dry cloth regularly and avoid using harsh chemicals.
- Do not discard the spare nuts, screw and key as they can come in handy in future.

Caution:

- The product must be assembled by an adult only. Keep all the parts out of the reach of kids until the product is fully assembled.
- Always sit upright and go down feet first on the slide. Climbing up the side, sliding down headfirst or in the standing position can be fatal and should be avoided at all costs.
- Abstain kids from jumping off the slide seat.
- Always place the product on an even surface. Using it on concrete or a rough surface can make it unsteady and may cause injuries.
- Packaging materials are used to safeguard the parts from damage during transportation and should be disposed of once the assembly is complete.
- This product is intended for use by kids over 2 years of age.
- Adult supervision is recommended when kids are using the product. .

Warnings:

- Always assemble on a non-abrasive surface to avoid scratches and make sure there are no sharp objects placed nearby.
- Do not connect any external item (chain, rope or cables) to the product.
- Avoid over-tightening the fasteners as it may cause damage to the parts.

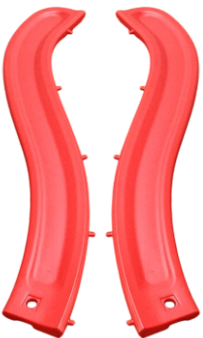

Assembly Instructions

Required Assembly Parts



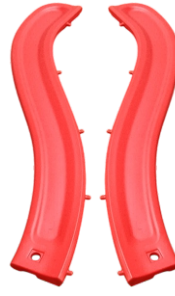
Big Slide



Small Nut x 10



Key x 1



Big Slide Handrail x 2

Before starting the assembly, lay out a carpet on the floor to avoid scratches.



Take a big left slide handrail and the big slide. Align the threaded pins underside the big left handrail with the holes along the edge of the big slide and push the handrail downwards, ensuring each of the threaded pins of the subassembly enters the corresponding hole on the slide handrail.

Note: Make sure that the big left handrail is positioned correctly with its mounting hole oriented at the bottom as shown in the images above

From the underside of the slide, place a nut onto the end of each threaded pin and tighten all the five nuts one by one, securing both the big slide and big handrail together.

Similarly, fasten the other big right handrail to the big slide.

Turn them face down.

Required Assembly Parts

2 STEP



Small Slide x 1



Small Slide Handrail x 2



Small Nut x 6



Key x 1



Take a small left handrail and the small slide. Align the threaded pins underside the small left handrail with the holes along the left side of the small slide and push the handrail downwards, ensuring each of the threaded pins of the small left handrail enters the corresponding hole on the slide.

Note: Make sure that the small left handrail is positioned correctly with its mounting hole oriented at the top as shown in the images above.

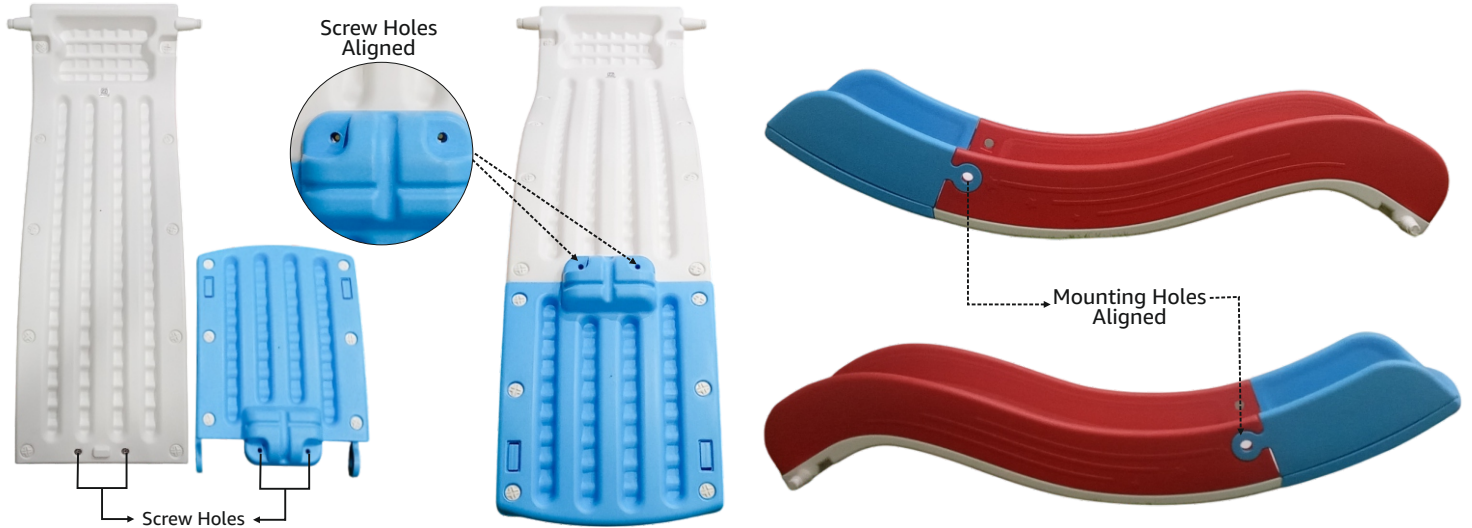
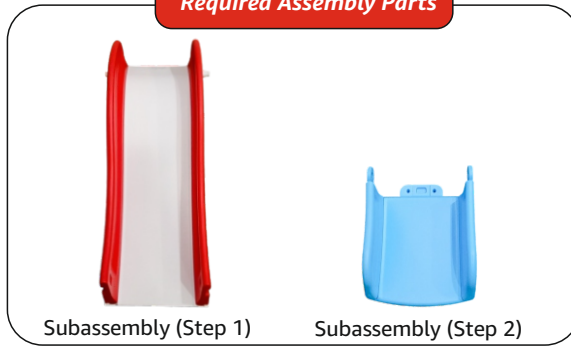
From the underside of the slide, place a nut onto the end of each threaded pin and tighten all the three nuts one by one, securing both the small slide and small handrail together.

Similarly, fasten the small right handrail to the small slide.

Turn them face down.

3 STEP

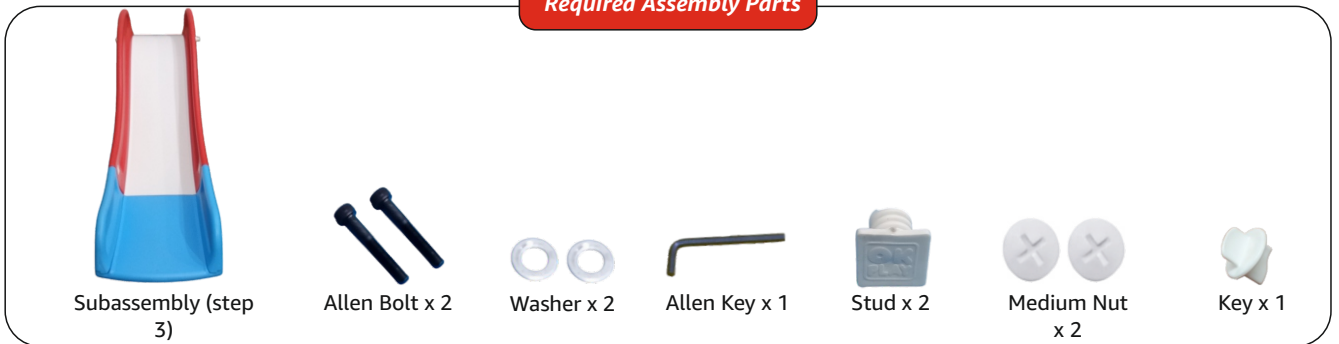
Required Assembly Parts



Take the big slide subassembly (step 1) and the small slide subassembly (step 2) and turn them face down. Next, align their screw holes making sure the small slide screw holes are over the screw holes of the big slide. Additionally, do make sure that the mounting holes of the big and small handrails are also in perfect alignment with each other.

4 STEP

Required Assembly Parts



Put a washer onto both the allen bolts and insert one allen bolt (with washer) into each aligned screw holes of the subassembly (step 3). Tighten both the allen bolts one by one with an allen key provided in the packaging.

- From the inner side of the slide subassembly, insert a stud into the aligned mounting holes as shown in the image.
- From the outer side, place a medium nut on the end of the stud and tighten the nut with the key.
- Repeat steps (A) and (B) on the other side of the subassembly to securely fasten both slide subassemblies together.

5 STEP

Take the left panel and all the four steps from the packaging, and secure each step to the side panel with a big nut as shown in the images above.

6 STEP

Take the slide subassembly (assembled in step 4), align its threaded pin on its edge (at the top) with the designated hole on the subassembly (step 5) and secure both together with a big nut.

Take the other side panel from the packaging and secure it to the subassembly (assembled in the previous step) with five big nuts.
